### **Spay N Save Animal Clinic Performs It's 25,000<sup>th</sup> Spay Neuter Surgery**

Longwood, FL January 22, 2016 — Spay N Save, Central Florida's first high quality, low cost spay/neuter clinic, announced today that it has performed their 25,000<sup>th</sup> surgery.

Since opening their doors only three and a half years ago and serving the community with affordable spay/neuters, vaccinations and testing, Spay N save remains dedicated and determined to reduce the number of healthy, adoptable animals killed in our local shelters. "We are proud to see that the in-take of cats and dogs at Seminole County Animal Services has significantly dropped in the years since we began" says Phyllis Ayoob, Spay N Save Executive Director.

And they've only just begun! "With the addition of another surgical suite, obtained through a grant from Franklin's Friends in 2015, our doctors can now perform up to 55 surgeries a day" said Phyllis Ayoob. By January 29, Spay N Save will have completed administering a grant from PetSmart Charities called "Happy Neuter Year" in which 140 neuter surgeries were performed on dogs and cats for a cost of only \$20 each. "We are a very proactive 501(c)3 organization and always working to secure funding and grants that allow us to continue reaching out to all pet owners, animal rescue organizations and community caregivers and making spaying and neutering accessible to them at an affordable cost" said Ayoob.

Having been voted Central Florida's Best Vet in 2013, 2014 and 2015 and also designated a top rated NonProfit with GreatNonProfits.com, Spay N Save looks forward to serving the community by providing high quality, low cost services for owners and their pets in 2016 and beyond.
